Director, Fogarty International Center
Associate Director for International Research, NIH

Dr. Glass's research interests are in the prevention of gastroenteritis from rotaviruses and noroviruses through the application of novel scientific research. He is a global champion for the development of safe, effective and affordable rotavirus vaccines and their inclusion in national programs for childhood immunization.

Dr. Glass has received numerous awards including the prestigious Charles C. Shepard Lifetime Scientific Achievement Award presented by the CDC in recognition of his 30-year career of scientific research application and leadership.

The competition will feature over 20 undergraduate teams from national and international universities who will present low-cost technologies they have designed to address global health challenges. Judges from industry, academia and medicine will evaluate the designs.
